Example One:

This is an example of a paragraph that doesn't use a drop cap. This paragraph is written using "Century Gothic" font, size twelve. The spacing is 1.15. I like the clean, crisp look it has.

Example Two:

This paragraph uses the same font as paragraph one. However, in this paragraph, the drop cap "dropped" option is on display. What do you think of this option? Do you enjoy seeing the drop cap used when you are reading a novel? This drop cap is "Old English Text MT" font. The lines to drop are set at three, and zero distance from the text.

Example Three:
